Let's join JPIC

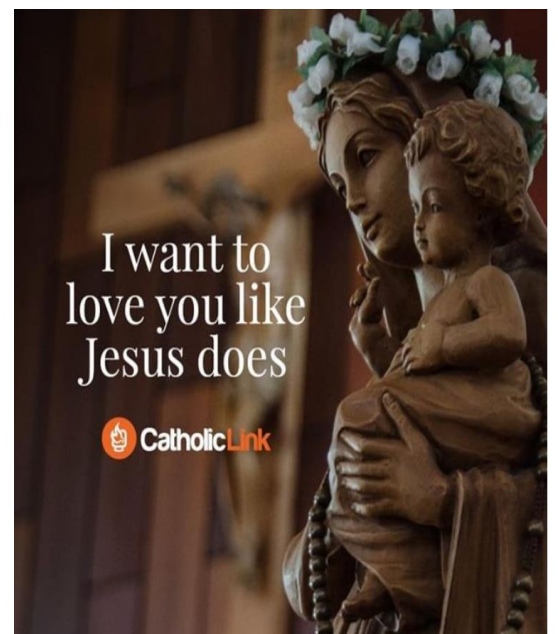
