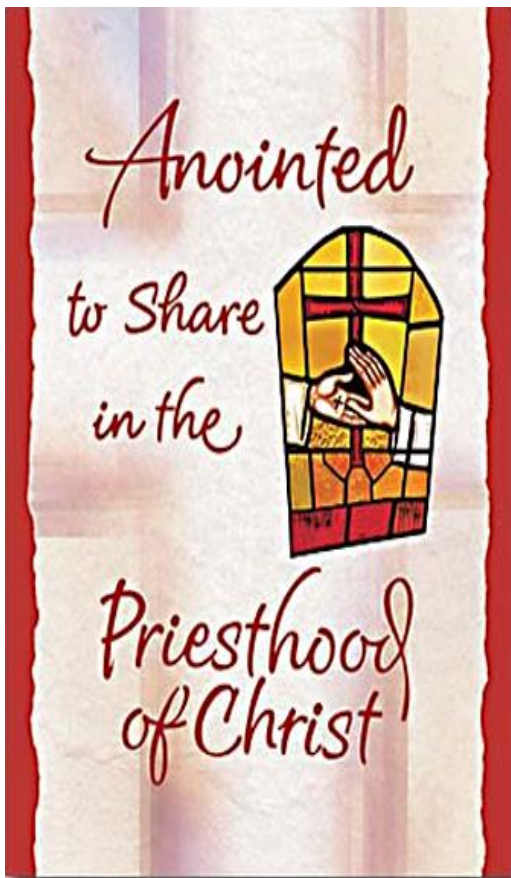

## An Important note from Fr. Pete

You have noticed or will notice some changes in church. The red carpet in the sanctuary has been removed. It was worn and burned. The original hardwood floor is now exposed. Also, the tabernacle has been moved directly behind the Altar of Sacrifice. The bishop is the chief liturgist of our diocese and our **Bishop Richard Stika** has directed all churches in the Diocese of Knoxville to comply with the following directive. He states, *“It (the tabernacle) should be the focal point of the church building because it contains the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. The placement of the tabernacle as well as the placement of the Altar of Sacrifice cannot be separated.”*

For those of you with an eye to detail, you will notice that the corners of the church have been refreshed. We are most grateful to **Spanish speaking parishioners** who have offered their talents in bringing about these changes. **We have not paid anything for this.** This has been a gift of talent and time.

*My prayer is that our worship of our Lord Jesus Christ be most beautiful and bear fruit in acts of charity and generosity.*
