Construction Notice!

All dates are tentative and updates/changes will be given through the Sentinel, School newsletter, Pulpit Announcements, and other mass media means.

1. The Lower Level Parking Lot Project has been approved by the Bishop; this is a Home Campaign Goal. Construction will begin on Sept. 10th, 2018. Access to the Lower Level from exterior doors will not be available to any person, group or ministry until Oct. 15th, 2018. The Walking Path will be closed in the area of construction during the same time period. The construction area will be fenced off for safety purposes.

2. The Re-Paving Project was approved by the Bishop; this is a long-range maintenance project. Paving will be from Oct 8th thru the 12th, 2018. All road surfaces will be addressed by repair, sealing, painting, and/or top coating. Access will remain open to all buildings, but EXPECT delays. Buildings will have no access when paving next to it. Building closures will be posted when the schedule is finalized.

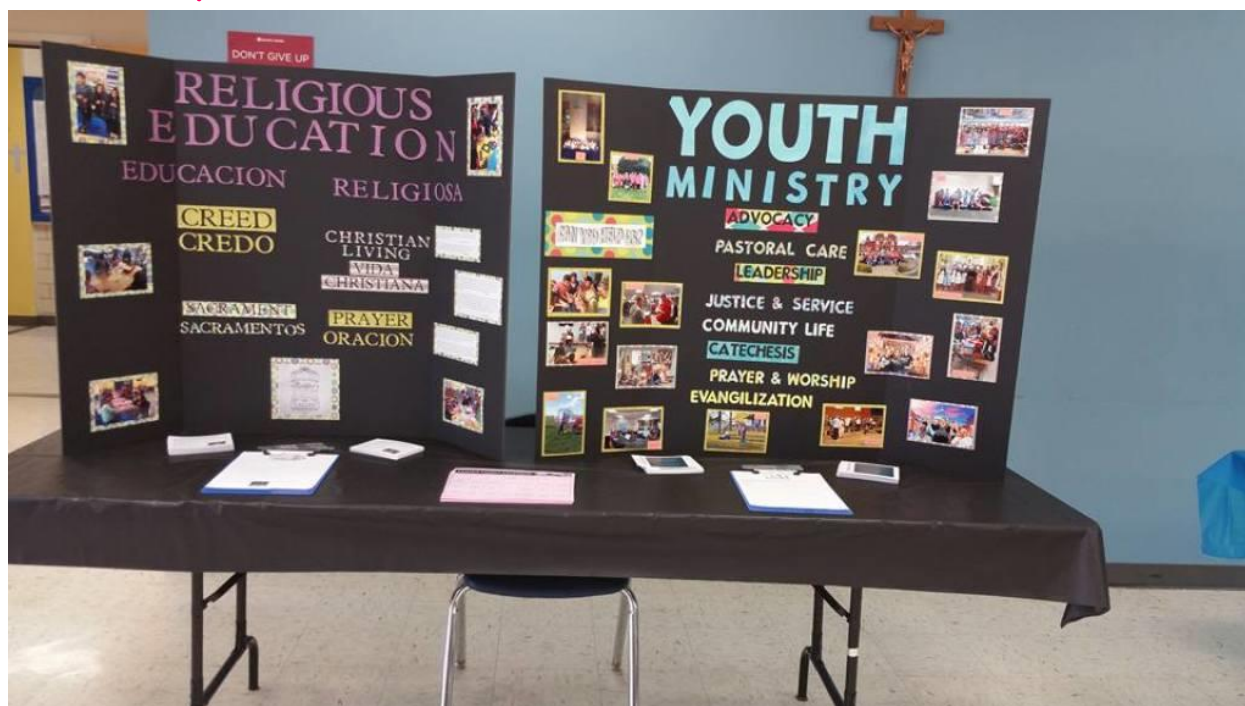
3. Sink Hole Repair Project was approved by the Bishop; this is amended to the parking lot construction and is a safety issue project. Assessment and abatement of sink holes near the school playground will occur immediately after parking lot construction is completed. The school parking lot will be closed during abatement; dates to be announced later.
